Over £1.1 million has been raised for local charities since 1972

Beatons Wood is a 24 acre ancient woodland which was formerly part of Michelham Priory estate. Purchased by the McCutchan family in 1922, it has stayed in the family ever since. The wood consists of oak trees that form the upper canopy with an understorey of hornbeam, sweet chestnut and hazel. In spring the magical display of wildflowers arrives; first the anemones and then the carpets of bluebells.

This is what we offer when you visit The Arlington Bluebell Walk:

- Walk through the **white wood anemones and bluebells** in the ancient oak woodland (flowers change depending on your time of visit)
- The main walk (half a mile) is **gravelled for wheelchairs** and mobility scooters (our single person scooters are available free of charge)
- **Seating every 150 meters**
- **Five other walks** (one to three miles) over farmland with a detailed map of all walks
- **Dogs on short leads welcomed**
- Visit the pygmy goats and the Kerry Hill ewe and lambs in **the Animal Barn** (hand-washing facilities available if you wish to have contact with the animals)
- **Memorial Glade** situated in the quiet area of Beatons Wood, to sit and remember those who are no longer with us
- **Children's quiz sheets** available, answers found on boards around the walks
- **Free car parking and designated accessible parking area**
- **Wheelchair accessible toilet**
- Designated **picnic area** with tables
- **Baby changing facilities**
- **Refreshments** provided by the duty charity in the Bluebell Barn
- **Wild bird live webcam** screen in the Bluebell Barn
- **Photographic exhibition** in the Animal Barn Gallery

Every spring, the flowers in Beatons Wood appear as:

- 1 A fresh green carpet of bluebell and anemone leaves
- 2 A white display of wood anemones against the backdrop of green leaves
- 3 A unique view of green, white and blue as the English bluebells emerge
- 4 Then many vistas of blue when the bluebells are fully out
- 5 Finally the wood darkens as the leaves on the trees unfurl and bluebells fade for another year

Exact timing of the appearance of wood anemones and bluebells is decided by nature, not us! Every Friday and Tuesday we post an update on our website and social media
