Creating a Tribute Page

How do I create a tribute page?

You can create your tribute page through our website. It only takes a few minutes and you will receive a link allowing you to personalise your page.

Is there a charge?

No. Tribute pages are completely free to create.

What can I add?

You can include:

- Photographs
 - Life stories and memories
 - Messages from family and friends
 - Music and videos
 - Funeral details
 - Fundraising events
 - Donation messages

Creating a Funeral Notice

What is a funeral notice?

A funeral notice allows you to share practical information about the funeral, including dates, times, locations and donation requests.

What details can I include?

You can include:

- Funeral date and time
- Venue information
- Wake arrangements
- Donation requests
- Maps and directions

What happens after the funeral?

Your page can remain as a lasting tribute for as long as you wish, allowing friends and family to continue sharing memories and making donations.

Using and Managing Your Tribute

Can family and friends contribute?

Yes. Friends and family can leave messages, upload photographs and share memories.

Can I edit my page?

Yes. You can update your tribute at any time.

Can I organise fundraising events?

Yes. Many people organise:

- Memory walks
- Coffee mornings
- Sponsored challenges
- Quiz nights
- Golf days
- Cake sales
- Charity events

These can all be linked to your tribute page.



Privacy and Access

Can my tribute be private?

Yes. You can choose whether your page is public or private.

Can I approve messages before they appear?

Yes. You control who can contribute and whether content requires approval.

Donations and Fundraising

Do I need to do anything with online donations?

No. Donations are transferred directly to Sussex Cancer Fund.

Can Gift Aid be claimed?

Yes. Eligible donations can include Gift Aid, increasing the value of the gift at no additional cost to the donor.

Are anonymous donations possible?

Yes. Donors can choose to remain anonymous or hide donation amounts.

Can I collect cash or cheques?

Yes. Offline donations can be added to your tribute page if you wish.
